With the support of the **Max Kade Foundation**, the **Department of German Studies at the University of Arizona** will award two first-year Max Kade Graduate Fellowships in the amount of \$14,000 each plus tuition fee remission for students beginning graduate work in Fall semester. The second year of graduate study will be funded by a graduate teaching assistantship.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the quality of their previous work in German and their potential for scholarly work in German Studies. In addition to the materials required of all applicants to the M.A. program, those interested in applying for the Fellowship should submit the following:

- 1) A brief statement describing how you are uniquely qualified for the Max Kade Fellowship (1 page limit).
- 2) A sample of scholarly writing in either German or English.

Acceptance of the Max Kade Graduate Fellowship entails the following:

- Enrollment in German 508 during the first year of graduate study
- Enrollment in at least nine credit hours per semester in German Studies courses

Deadline for submission of completed application: March 1 for domestic applicants. Non-US applicants are urged to submit applications as soon as possible.
