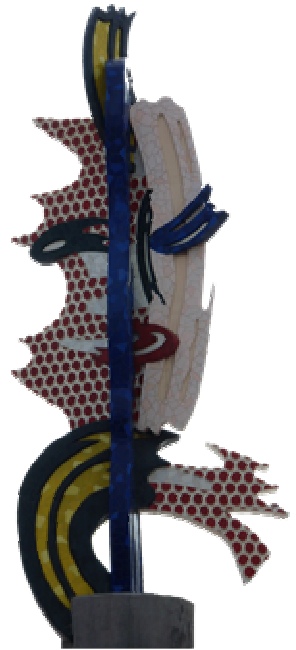
### “20th Annual Graduate and Professional Symposium on Hispanic and Luso-Brazilian Literature, Language and Culture”
